CANTON, la Chinoise

a film by Robert Cahen and Rob Rombout

Thay say Canton is the most chinese of cities. But it is also a megalopolis where eight million people live. A limitless, endlessly rebuilt city, with no apparent structure. A furious city where the remnants of the past are disappearing under the concrete and tarmac, where chaos rules over the organization of time and space... A city that embodies a system which is not a system any more.

The protagonists, or messengers, of the film, are between two cultures (Christian Mérer, Chen Tong), between two systems, (Carine... her family), or between two conceptions of art (Lin Yilin, Zhang Haier). Each of them is preoccupied by his own cultural survival. Above all, they are doomed to observe a gigantic urban transformation.

In this experimental documentary, the five characters form an involuntary group faced with the human mass. There is constantly a screen between these actors and their décor – a window, photograph, painting, language difficulty, etc.

Being in China without being in China. Intimate feelings, tellings signs, strolls. Words and images blend into the vision of an incredibly mobile and perhaps imaginary city...

Robert CAHEN

born in Valence, worked in Paris and Mulhouse. After earning a degree from the National Higher Conservatory of Music of Paris in 1971, he became a member of the Musical Research Group of ORTF and then took charge of experimental video research (INA) until 1976. He has also won the Villa Medicis "beyond the walls" prize (1992). Robert Cahen, trained as a composer, studied with Pierre Schaeffer, and became, in twenty years' time, one of the most important personalities in the field of video creation. He set up a permanent video installation in Lille at Euralille (1995) and has taken part with his installations since 1997 at different international Contemporary Art exhibitions (Switzerland, Italy, Germany, Canada, Peru, US, France).
